2026 Edmonton Regional Heritage Fair

The [Edmonton Regional Heritage Fair \(ERHF\)](#) is like a Science Fair but for Social Studies. It is an opportunity for students in grades 4 through 9 to research, write, and present projects on a topic in Canada's history, geography, culture, or heritage. We encourage students to pick a topic that interests them and aim to foster curiosity in Canadian history and heritage.

On the day of the fair, as a demonstration of learning, students exhibit and present their projects to 3 or more judges from the community who provide written feedback to the students on the day of the fair. Project scores will be provided to the teachers at a later date.

Since the fair is designed to celebrate student success and curiosity, all students will receive a certificate recognizing their participation in the fair. A select number of students will receive special awards from our partner organizations, and two projects will be selected to advance to [Canada's History National Showcase](#).

- The 2026 Fair is taking place on **Sat. May 2, 2026**
- Student registration opens at **8:00 am**. Judging is from approx. **10 am - 12:30 pm**.
- The closing ceremony begins at **12:30 pm**.
- The Fair takes place at the **Prince of Wales Armouries Heritage Centre** at 10440 108 Ave NW in Edmonton. Parking available.
- The ERHF is open to homeschooled & in-school learners.
- The fee for the 2026 Fair is **\$12/student**. **We cannot accept cash payments on the day of the fair.** Cheques can be made out to the *Edmonton Regional Heritage Fair Society*.
